**For all Optimist Fleets, Lasers and Club 420's
OCTOBER 20 AND 21, 2007**

1 Rules

1. The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2005-2008 (RRS), the prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association (US Sailing), by the rules of the International Optimist Dinghy Association, the Laser Class Association or the 420 Class Association as appropriate to the fleet and this Notice Of Race, except as any of these are changed by the Sailing Instructions or any appendices to the Sailing Instructions.

2. Event The organizing authority is the Lake Eustis Sailing Club. The event will be held at the Lake Eustis Sailing Club, 1310 CR 452, Eustis, FL 32726

3 Eligibility and Entry

3.1 All Optimist competitors must have been born on or after January 1, 1992.

3.2 The Optimist Green Fleet is open to any beginning Optimist sailor who meets the criteria specified by the United States Optimist Dinghy Association.

3.3 The Club 420, Laser and Laser Radial Fleets are open for all junior sailors, up to 18 years of age.

3.4 Competitors must have completed all parts of the entry form and liability release document must be signed by parent/guardian of any participating junior sailor prior to the close of on-site registration.

4 Designated Adult

4.1 All competitors under the age of 18 must have an adult representative. The adult representative must agree in writing, at registration, to be responsible for the competitor throughout the event.

4.2 It is the competitor's designated adult's decision to enter the regatta and to start or continue any race. The adults supervising the competitors are ultimately responsible for the competitor. This includes insuring that the competitor wears appropriate clothing for immersion in cold water. The designated adult will accept full responsibility for all actions of the competitor during any activity related to the event. This includes on-shore activities before, during, and after the regatta.

7 Fees

7.1 Required Fees (checks should be made payable to Lake Eustis Sailing Club):

The entry fee for each boat is \$60 with a \$10 late fee after October 12, 2007; Entry fee for Club 420 is \$80.- add \$10 for registration after October 10th .

7.2 Entry fee includes breakfast and lunch for the competitors on both race days, BBQ dinner on Saturday night and nice Participants memento.

8 Sailing Instructions

The Sailing Instructions will be available at the time of registration.

9 Courses & Racing Area

9.1 The racing area for all classes will be on Lake Eustis in front of the sailing club. The sailing instructions will designate the course for the classes.

10 Scoring

10.1 The low-point scoring system (rule A2) will apply, except that each boat's worst score will be discarded if more than six (6) races are completed. Otherwise there will be no throw-outs. This changes rule A2.

10.2 One race completed constitutes a regatta.

10.3 In the case of a tie, an absolute tie breaker will be used as follows: (1) the skipper with the most firsts, (2) most seconds, thirds, etc. (3) the skipper beating the other the most times, and if still tied, (4) the skipper beating the other in the last race.

10.4 Optimists classes will not be exempt from displaying a red flag in a protest situation. (Changes RRS 61.1(a).

Red: 1-5; Blue: 1-5; White: 1-5; Green: Participation Awards for all competitors.

Lasers: Each class: 1-5.
